Remote Education Provision

Dear Parents / Carers,

We are all extremely disappointed that we are unable to have all children in school for this half term. We would like to thank all children and parents for their hard work and support this week in becoming familiar with the remote learning provision. It has been a steep learning curve for all involved but we appreciate everything you are doing to support your children at home.

Remote learning

Class teachers have worked hard to have Google classroom set up with learning available for your children. Given the increased expectations for remote learning from the government, all staff are committed to building on the success of last year and improving where we can.

Starting on Monday 11th January, we will offer a dedicated interactive teacher time for each class group. Your child's class session will be at the same time every day over the next five weeks, hosted on Zoom.

We have staggered these times, as we are extremely conscious of the demands for access to laptops/tablets within households. Please do get in touch with school if you require support with this.

Expectations

It is expected that all children will log into Google Classroom every morning and attend the morning session for their class on a daily basis. Teachers will be completing a register and starting the session promptly, at the allocated time; please be on time. We hope that this will be a useful opportunity to engage and motivate the children for the learning ahead that day. Teachers will be setting learning to be completed independently on Google classroom. Work will be set as an 'Assignment' and should be uploaded and submitted into the daily folder each day.

In line with our school marking policy (a copy can be located on the school website), we will expect work to be presented to a high standard. To aid this we will be arranging for a set of exercise books to be collected from the office. When completing work in their book, children should record the date and learning objective (this can be found on the planning). Children in Year R – 3 should use a pencil to record their work. Children in Y4 -6 can use a pen (blue or black) for English, Science, themed and pencil for Maths. Please encourage your child to start a new page for each new piece of learning.
