The Expected Standard

Children are at the expected standard when they achieve a scaled score of 100 or more, calculated from their test score.

How many children met the expected standard in all three subjects?

63% of children in school achieved the expected standard in all three subjects, reading, SPAG and maths, compared to 61% nationally.

Average Progress

This is a measure of the progress children make between the end of Key Stage 1 (Year 2) to the end of Key Stage 2 (Year 6).

Reading	2.8 significantly better than the national average
Writing	0.7 not significantly different from national
Maths	-0.4 not significantly different from national

A score of zero means pupils in this school on average do about as well at KS2 as those with similar attainment nationally.
